main ditch to a maple at the mouth of a small branch which  
comes into said Creek from the South. Thence up said branch to a  
black oak at the head of the swamp Thence S St E 22 Ch to a  
stake Thence to a gum at the head of a branch on W Dicks  
land Thence down the meanders of the Branch to the river  
Thence up the River to the beginning supposed to contain about  
Two hundred and thirty acres.
