of February in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and fifty five between Samuel W. Towne
Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville
and District of Greenville County House in the said State of the one part
and H. A. Forester of the other part Whereas the said Forester

one thousand eight hundred and fifty five exhibit his Bill of
complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Ct House in the
said State against Caroline Hodges, Asa Hodges and Massie
Taylor and others praying among other matters that the commissioners
of the said court should do execute good and sufficient titles to a
certain tract of land herein after described in behalf of the heirs
of John W. Hodges deceased deceased and the
cause being an issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard
at July Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and fifty four when the said Court after full hearing thereof did mat
deliberation in the premises did order Adjudge and decree that said
Commissioner Should do execute said titles to the said Forester
and Forester

Now Therefore This Indenture witnesseth That the said
 Samuel W. Towne as Commissioner of the said Court under
 and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum
 of five dollars paid by the said Forester the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold and released
 and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell and release unto
 the said Forester his Heirs and assigns all that tract or
 parcel of land known and described as follows by a Survey of the
 same made by A. C. Hardin D. S. 37th August 1854 to wit Beginning
 at the Maple Tree on Brushy Creek Thence Wrd 49th thrd to Stake
 in state line thence S⁸⁷ W¹⁷ E⁷⁰ corner, thence S³⁰ W¹⁷ E⁸⁵ to Stake in
 state line with state line to a small Maple on state line
 thence S²⁰ W¹⁶ E⁷⁵ thence N⁸⁰ E⁴¹ to Poplar
 branch on Brushy Creek thence with said creek to the beginning corner
 and Witch Hazel tree all of which lands are lying and being situated
 in the State and District aforesaid and containing by said Survey Two
 hundred and twenty acres more or less

Together with all and singular the hereditaments
 Right Members and Appurtenances wheresoever the said Land
 belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining unto the Reserves
 and Remainders Heretofore issued and Profits thereof and also all the
 estate, Right, Title Interest, Power Possession, Property, Benefit claim
 and Demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the heirs and
 Representatives of the said John W. Hodges deceased and of all the parties
 to this suit also of all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim
 the same as any part thereof by from or under them or either of them
 to hold the said Land with its boundaries
