of a Writ of Execution issued out of the Court of Common Pleas
held for the District of Grenville to the tenth day of November in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one at the
Court of Henry Good to me the said Justice commanding me that the
goods and chattels lands and tenements of Daniel Harrison to pay the
sum of One hundred and thirteen dollars being damage and cost of
chancery and taking of the lands and tenements of the said Daniel Harri-
son at that certain price, parcel and tract of Land containing One
hundred and thirty four acres situate and lying in the District of Granville
in Vaughan Creek Branch, waters of Packatuck River adjoining
lands of Mrs Martha Fisher, Green Mills & others being the
same Street whereon Daniel Harrison now resides

And whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the
day made by virtue of the said writ of Execution before mentioned have
been offered to sale at publick vendue and purchased by Benjamin F.
Perry of the District of Grenville for the sum of Two hundred and

its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the
said Daniel Harrison of right had of in and to the same
