of the State into District aforesaid for and con-
sideration of the sum of one hundred and ten
only five dollars to me in hand paid by James Henson of the same State and
District the receipt and payment are fully acknowledged that he aforesaid did
and conveighed and by these presents doth again sell and convey a certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in said State and District on wild cat
Branch of Tottenberry Creek waters of middle Tige River with the said James Henson
sons care during their natural life for the use of Elijah Henson his son and his
heirs at the death of the said James Henson Beginning on a Red Oak
on Packes Mountain the corner of the Clayton Branch fence nearly South with
the line of the Grant to the Branch on Willow Pond line. Thence down the branch
as it meanders far enough to be running in a North direction to Swift's line to
maple ~~first~~^{and} ~~three~~^{fourth} ~~part~~^{part} of Swift's line
to the beginning together with all and singular the Rights, members said
branches and opportunities belonging to the same or in anywise incident or app-
ertaining thereto. The said Edward Hill doth of myself my heirs Executors Administrators
and assigns warrant and cause defend the above mentioned premises unto the
said James Henson and at his death to his son Elijah Henson his heirs Executors
Administrators and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns for and a-
gainst every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming at to claim
the same or any part thereof.

and seal this 23rd day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight
hundred and fifty one.
