Know all men by these presents that I Thornton P Poole now of the said District and State but being about to remove to the State of Texas for divers good causes and consideration now thence moving have made constitute and appointed and by these presents do hereby make constitute and appoint also H Beanes of Greenville District aforesaid to be my true sufficient and lawful Attorney for me and in my name and stead to transact all business of any kind whatsoever which I may leave unsettled in South Carolina to do whatever may yet be necessary to be done by me as Executor of the last will and testament of my late father John P. Poole deceased to ask demand sue for and receive any and all sums of money which may now be or may hereafter be due and owing to me to execute full receipts releases and acquittances for the same and generally to do all and whatsoever may be necessary to be done legally in pursuance of these presents as fully and absolutely as I might or could do the same were I personally present.

Honestly ratifying and confirming against myself my heirs executors and administrators all things whatsoever my said Executor may do in pursuance of these presents.
