of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by William H. Cobb
of the State and District aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
have granted Bargained Sold and Released and by these presents do
Grant, Bargain, Sell and release unto the said William H. Cobb a certain
Tract or plantation of Land containing One Hundred and Thirteen acres
to the same more or less Situate in the State and District aforesaid on both
sides of the Hardy Fork of the River Beginning at Pine 3x and dead on the
West side of said Hardy Fork Creek running thence N^E 44⁴⁴ W 45.5 chains
to Rock 3 from Pine N 14⁴⁴ W 34.75 chains to Rock 3 from thence N 67⁴⁴
E 13.25 chains to Rock 3 from on the west side of said Hardy Fork
thence due East 3.50 chains to Post Oak 3 from thence S 24⁴⁴ W 18.30
chains to Pine 3 from thence S 88⁴² W 19.00 chains to Pine 3 from a branch
River "not made now" thence S 36⁴⁴ W 11.50 chains to the beginning
Pine

claim the same or any part thereof.
