W. 8.5 ch to a W. Oak Thence S 44° E. 11.5 ch to a chestnut on the bank of  
the Creek Thence down said Creek 5.5 ch to the junction of the two branches  
Thence up said branch to the beginning correctly estimation Forty Acres  
more or less unto the said W. C. Head his heirs and assigns forever & do hereby  
being myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & forever defend  
the said premises unto the said W. C. Head his heirs and assigns forever against  
all suits my heirs Executors, Administrators
