Suber one of the heirs of said deceased containing One hundred and twenty five acres the same more or less beginning at a Maple tree on the bank of the Creek adjoining lands of Eliza Lanning running down the meanders of said Creek some ten chains to a sawwood dead Thence S 39 E 2.14 mds to a stone & Thence S 8 E 1.88 ds to a Brook from which Thence up the meanders of the white plain Branch some 45 chains to a Stake 33 mds on Lanning's line thence N 33 1/2 W 23.34 obs to Stake originally a Post Oak Thence S 89 1/2 E 23.30 obs to a Stake, Thence S 27 1/2 E 15.64 stone now Thence S 5 1/2 E 30.36 obs in the beginning
