acknowledged hath granted, bargained, sold and released and by these
presente doth grant, bargain sell and release unto the said James W.
Hodges his heirs and assigns all that Tract or parcel of land containing
the Hodges House & Stone Fence Situated in Greenville District of said State on both
sides the State Road & on both sides the North Fork of Saluda River
containing Two Thousand Four Hundred and one Acres more or less
being the same Tract of Land set forth and described completely by lines
courses & distances by a plat of the same Surveyed & marked as part of this
deed which was made and certified by James W. Dickson Deputy Sur-
veyor on December 21st 1853 bounded South by lands of the said James W.
Hodges East by lands unknown to Mr. McCallahan, North by lands
of Richard Howard and other lands which were of the estate of J. W. Hodges
deceased & located on the lands of Humpfries and
Goodwin
