days before such examination actually join the Plaintiff in executing the
deed of release aforesaid as is that the said release was positively and bona
fide executed at least seven days before such her examination and that
she did then at the execution of the said release and still does at the time
of examination freely voluntarily and without any measure of com
pulsion due to fear of any person or persons whomsoever to renounce
