H. Sloan, the DeLancan, J. M. Roberts and Mary J. Roberts bearing date the first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty and witnessed by J. M. Roberts and Mary J. Roberts and recorded in the office of the Register of Meigs conveyance Book No. 3 page 257, 258, 259 as by reference thereto will more fully appear and we have received an interest and share in said lands or lots before described but have not formally released our title to the same. In consideration of the premises and in consideration of the sum of ten dollars to us paid in hand by the said G. J. Jones we Charles J. Elford and Sarah A. Elford and Mary J. Roberts have granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said G. J. Jones all our right title and interest and claim of what kind or name we are to the lots of land of us said which are set forth and described in the deed of conveyance to him herein described.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George J. Jones his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George J. Jones his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same of any part thereof by or through us.
