Now all newly these presents that I James M Daily of the State aforesaid do not opposed or in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Wm H Bramlett of the same State and District have granted, have granted sold and released and by these presents do Grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Wm H Bramlett his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing Eighty Acres more or less on the waters of South Tyger River adjoining lands of the estate of David Daily dec<sup>d</sup>, J S Westmoreland and W L Drake & J W M Hugh beginning at a red oak in M Street line Thence N 40 W 23 to a black oak st Thence S 86 W 23 to a pine st Thence S 40 E 25 30 to a stake on Street of line Thence S 48 W a bark & chains to a stake the corner of the Swaffo Grant Thence with the line N 30 W about 13 chains to the line of the State land granted to the said J M Daily Thence along said line S 33 W about 4 chains to a red oak st in W Westmoreland line Thence S 45 E 27 30 to a stake Thence N 13 E 18 50 to a pine st Thence N 86 E to the beginning corner

Together with all and singular the rights number bounds landmarks and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining

To have and hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Wm Bramlett his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Wm Bramlett his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons who shall lawfully claim the same or any part thereof
