Know all men these presents that  
John Westfield of the State and District

aforsaid in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in  
hande paid of Simon Ecken of the State and District, have bargained sold  
and released by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
said Simon Ecken a certain piece of land containing seven nine acres <sup>or thereabouts</sup> with  
some more or less, situated in Greenville Dist and State aforsaid lying on the  
Warren branch, and hath such corners, fens, and marks, as a plat  
therunto annexed, beginning at a stake on the N. W. C. A. down the meander  
of said road to a stake thence N 77 W 1/2 to a stake, thence S 72 W 20 to a pine  
thence N 85 to a pine, thence N 89 E 49 1/2 to a stake on the Warren Ferry road thence  
along the said road to the beginning. Being a part of the land tract whereon Simon  
Ecken now lives, bounded by lands of C. Garrison, Smallerwood Dalton, W. Garrison  
Vothus, together with all and singular the said premises unto the said Simon Ecken his heirs  
and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors, & administra-  
tors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
said Simon Ecken his heirs, executors, administrators against myself my heirs  
& against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part thereof. Thus as witness my hand and seal, and delivered in the  
year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred fifty six M<sup>o</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> 1856
