Brown all my true presents that I John Westfield of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of Two Thousand two hundred and thirty two dollars and five paisa by W. S. Howell of Greenville dist. aet. and State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and released unto the said W. S. Howell all of the presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said W. S. Howell all of Tract or Parcel of Land containing one hundred and eighty six acres more or less situate in the District and State aforesaid abutting the same tract or parcel of land conveyed by Avery Hough to Ralph John Westfield by a deed bearing date the twenty ninth day of October 1834 bounded and described as follows, beginning at the confluence of Mill Creek on Saluda River thence down with the meanders of said creek to a Hick Oak Thence \$486 7.50 to a Pork Oak Thence \$85 6.375 to a pine Thence \$886 19.50 to a pine Thence \$82 8.32.25 to a Black Oak Thence \$468 8.00 to a peak Oak Thence \$86 32.50 to a large poplar on a branch thence down the meanders of said branch to Mill creek thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning at the confluence of said creek and Saluda River and also one acre more or less on the North side of Mill creek bounded as follows commencing near the shoal and running thence to a Pork oak there \$31 6.38 to a water oak Thence \$43 6.50 to an ash on the creek and thence down said Creek to the shoal for the use and propertage of said Shoal together with all and singular the rights, members, franchises and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto.

I do have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said W. S. Howell his heirs and assigns against myself and them and all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same and do hereby bind myself my heirs and executors administrators and successors in law and do from and forever discharge the said premises unto the said W. S. Howell his heirs and assigns forever.
