because the William Bain and John Bain as Executors to said Will
and Testament of Greenville District in the aforesaid State to us paid
by William Bain of Greenville District in the aforesaid State sum of one thousand
two hundred and twenty dollars and twenty five cents
and released unto the said William Bain all that piece of land and
tract of Land lying and being in Greenville District on the South side
of Ready River containing one hundred and eighty acres more or less
being known as the Bain place and formerly a George Bain deceased
of John Watson Ordinary of Greenville District, in distribution among
the heirs of Benjamin Mann deceased and now held by the Exec-
utors of George Bain deceased in distribution among the heirs of the
said George Bain deceased Beginning at Black Gum 3x a black tree
thence S 50 W 18.30 chs to a Stake 3x Stone. N 25 W 14 chs to a pine
tree S 50 W 28.30 chs to a Stake 3x Stone. N 50 W 44.30 chs to a
swayas 3x Stone. S 50 E 24.00 to a Hickory 3x Stone. S 44 E 3.10 chs
to a Stake in a Stump 3x Stone. N 42 E 9.30 chs to a marker east 3x tree
the said Stone thence down the meanders of said River to the beginning
of the river.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, franchises
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise inci-
pient or appertaining To them and to them all and singular the sum
so before mentioned unto the said William Bain his heirs and assigns
forever And we do hereby name George Bain, his Executors and
Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the

said premises unto the said William Bain his heirs and assigns
against them and their heirs and against every other person whom
he may lawfully claiming to claim the same as aforesaid things
which he has and will seal this thirty first day of March
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty
two and in the 7th Year of the Sovereignty
and Independence of the United States of America
