Ashmore Sen of the State and District aforesaid

for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred

Dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas P. Ashmore of the State and district aforesaid  
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas P. Ashmore  
and his heirs and assigns a certain piece parcel or tract of Land containing Ten Acres situate in the State and  
District aforesaid on both sides of the New Ford Creek branch waters of Needy River  
beginning at a Rock 340 m thence N 44° 45' 90 to Rock 341 m thence N 25 W 116 ch to Pine  
342 m thence N 54 66.25 ch to Rock 343 m thence S 38 617.00 ch to Rock 344 m thence S 34 2  
63.00 ch to Rock 345 m thence S 37 W 2.21 ch to the beginning Rock. Together with  
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto  
concerning or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and  
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas P. Ashmore his heirs  
and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said Thomas  
P. Ashmore his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs executors and  
administrators and against every person or persons whomever lawfully claim  
it holding or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this  
the ninth day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred  
and fifty six and in the eight first year of the Independence of the United
