Know all men by these presents that I
J. H. Randolph of the District and State of

South Carolina aforesaid in consideration of One One thousand and seventy dollars
to me in hand paid hath bargained sold and delivered and by these
presents doth bargain sell and deliver unto Vardry McBee of the District
and State aforesaid the following property (viz) One negro girl Eliza a
about eighteen years of age and one negro boy Isaac about fifteen
years of age. To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid
negro slaves Eliza and Isaac unto the said Vardry McBee his
Administrators and assigns forever. Provided nevertheless and it is
expressly agreed between the said parties that if the said J. H. Randolph
his executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid
unto James A. McCarter of the District and State aforesaid a certain
note drawn and payable twelve months after date with interest from
date say the 12th day of January 1837 eighteen hundred and fifty seven
or One thousand and seventy dollars for which the said Vardry Mc
Bee is bound as security in the full sum above stated which the
said J. H. Randolph has this day given and made payable to the said
James A. McCarter or bearer according to the intent and meaning
