N 55 W 30' to stone N 65° 10' E 10' to cedar tree N 53 E 50' to beginning
corner containing eight acres one half acres more or less together
with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appertinances to the same belonging or pertaining to have
and to hold the said lot of land unto the said James McCullough
in his heirs and assigns forever and I hereby bind myself my
heirs and assigns to warrant and defend the said lot of land
