S. Bounded by lands of J. B. Spauldy A. L. Cobb and others being part of a tract of land that said A. L. Cobb purchased at the sale of the estate lands of Miss Doreen of Greenville. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Martin Wright his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Martin Wright his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
