in the state aforesaid for and in Consideration of the
sum of three thousand six hundred and ten dollars to
us paid by Samuel Jones of the County of Greenville in
the state aforesaid we have granted bargained sold and
released and by the presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said Samuel Jones all that tract or
parcel of land situate lying and being in the County
and state aforesaid on both sides of Ready River and
also on both sides of Saunders Creek waters of Ready
River and embracing the junction of the said streams
adjoining lands of the estate of Gertrude Cleveland deceased
Baptist Mrs L. S. Young and the said William Bates
and Company Beginning at a stone 34 m near a Hickory
stump between the said Ready River and Saunders Creek
and running S 41° 45' 10" E to a stone 34 m thence S 83° 30'
W 45° 00' E to a stone 34 m on the public Road thence S 77° 45'
E 5' E along the public Road and Crooking the said Ready
River to a bend in the said road thence N 77° 45' E 5' E
to a bend in the said road thence S 38° 44' W 12° 15' E to a bend
in the said road thence S 82° W 16° 15' E to a stone 34 m
on the said public road thence S 40° 47' 10" E 11° 45' E
