 To Etal To Greenville District  
 Thomas Sykes Land Whereas John T. Coleman late  
 of the District and State aforesaid  
 said by his last will and testament amongst  
 other dispositions of his estate devised and  
 bequeathed to his wife Amelia Coleman a cer-  
 tain tract or parcel of land containing about  
 seventy six and one half acres designated as  
 the homestead and described in said will  
 to have and to hold the same during her natural  
 life and at her death the said tract of land  
 to be sold by his executors and the proceeds of said  
 sale to be divided into three equal parts, one of  
 which he gave to his brother Jones H. Coleman  
 one to his brother-in-law Hardy Clark and the  
 remaining part to the relatives or legatees of his  
 wife as she might direct and amongst the said  
 Amelia Coleman Jones H. Coleman and Hardy Clark the  
 devisees aforesaid by and with the consent of Henry C. Young  
 one of the executors of said will to sell the said tract  
 of land and substitute the proceeds of said sale in lieu  
 thereof the interest therein to be paid to the said Amelia  
 Coleman during her natural life the principal to be  
 distributed as directed by the will of the said John  
 T. Coleman Now know all men by these presents that  
 the said Jones H. Coleman Amelia Coleman and Hardy  
 Clark executors devisees under the will of the said John  
 T. Coleman and Henry C. Young executor of said will  
 in consideration of the sum of four thousand six  
 hundred and fifty dollars aforesaid to be paid by Dr. Thomas  
 Sykes of Hincapie District in the state aforesaid have  
 bargained sold released and conveyed land by the present  
 and bargain sell release and convey unto the said  
 Thomas Sykes all that tract or parcel of land known  
 before mentioned situated lying and being in the  
 District of Greenville and about one mile and a  
 forth from Greenville Village in the state aforesaid  
 containing seventy six and one half acres and upon  
 which the late Mrs. T. Coleman formerly resided and  
 the said Amelia Coleman now resides and having such  
 shape marks and boundaries as the plot annexed to this  
 and represents together with all and singular the  
 rights muniments hereditaments and appurtenances  
 of the said premises belonging thereto in incident  
 in appertaining to have and to hold all and  
 singular the right franchises hereditaments and  
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
 thereto in incident thereto as well as to the use and  
 benefit of the same in all time past and future
