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William Bates & Co Gr W J Dargan	Deed To Land	The State of South Carolina Greenville County Know all men by these presents that we William Bates Thomas Mc Cox and Henry P Hammatt being the members of the firm of William Bates and Company, all of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand eight hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Doctor William James Dargan of the County and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and releases unto the said William James Dargan all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid about five miles above the City of Greenville on the west side of the Buncombe Road, and on both sides of Sanders Creek, waters of Reedy River, adjoining laundry the Duncan's Chappell Church lot. Mrs C of Hill the tract of land recently sold by the said W Bates & Co to Capt W C Easton the lot also sold by them to Samuel L Jones. The lands of Mrs A J Young and also lands belonging to the said William Bates & Co. It being a part of the tract of land purchased by the said W Bates & Co from the late Perry E Duncan deceased. And is more fully described by a plat made by William A Hendon & dated August 11, 1870.
