

William J. Whitmire Deed The State of South Carolina
 To the Town Council Land

I, William J. Whitmire of Greenville
 State of South Carolina in Consideration that the
 Intendant and wardens of the Town of Greenville in the
 State of South Carolina shall and do within three months
 from the date hereof, and at the expense of the said Town of
 Greenville, remove the fence on the East side of the lot herein
 after described to a position feet within that on which
 it now stands and then re-erect the said fence, and that
 the said Intendant and wardens of the said Town of Greenville
 shall and do within the time specified and likewise
 at the expense of the said Town of Greenville construct a good
 and substantial sidewalk along the street on the East of
 and adjoining the said lot and in further consideration
 of the sum of five dollars to me paid by the said Intendant
 and wardens of the said Town of Greenville do hereby release
 release surrender and abandon unto the said Intendant
 and wardens of the said Town of Greenville and unto their
 successors in office an area or space of feet in
 width along the East side of the lot of land situate on the
 west side of River Street in the said Town of Greenville and
 bounded on the North by the lands of Edward S. Irvin on the
 South by Court Street and by the lot wherein my residence is
 now situated and on the West by the lands of Alexander McRae
 being the same lot conveyed to me by the aforesaid Edward S.
 Irvin by Deed bearing date the 15 day of April in
 the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
 forty eight the said area or space to extend in length
 from the line of the said Edward S. Irvin on the
 North to the said Court Street on the South to,
 have and to hold all and singular the said area
 and space of Land unto the said Intendant and
 wardens of the said Town of Greenville and unto
 the successors in office for the purpose of
 adding to and widening the said River Street and
 for the use of the same by the Public for that
 purpose and for no other purpose whatsoever
 and it is hereby expressly declared and stipulated
 that of the said area of Land or any part thereof
 shall at any time hereafter be used or appropriated
 for any other than said purpose the whole
 of the same shall immediately revert to
 me and be held by me my heirs and
 assigns in fee simple and I do hereby bind
 my self my heirs executors and administrators
 to warrant and defend all and

singular the area and space unto the said Intendant
 and wardens of the said Town of Greenville and
 to them successors in office against me and my heirs
 and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or
 to claim the same witness my hand and Seal this
 twenty eighth day of May in the year of our Lord
 one thousand Eight hundred and Sixty eight and in
 the Ninety second year of the Sovereignty and
 Independence of the United States of America
