Greenville & R.R. Co To Noah Ferguson	Deed For Lot	The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company a body corporate of the said State for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to them paid by Noah Ferguson of Greenville District in the said State, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Noah Ferguson a certain piece parcel and lot of land containing about one acre situate lying and being in the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville in the State and near the depot of the said company being laid down as Lot No 2 in the plan of the said Company's lots at Greenville drawn by C. Roemer March 1854 and having the following boundaries and dimensions viz beginning at a Stake on Pendleton Street or road and running thence with said Street or road one hundred feet, thence with Lot No 3 four hundred and thirty three feet to a Stake thence with a 30 feet lane or street one hundred and three feet to a Stake and thence with Thomas M. Coxes lot four hundred and thirty three feet to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and app- urtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Noah Ferguson his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company do hereby bind themselves and their successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Noah Ferguson his heirs and assigns, against the said Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company their successors and assigns and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Person their President and their corporate seal to be thereto affixed this the fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four and in the seventy ninth year after the independence of the United States of America, signed sealed and delivered in presence of Charles W. Leamington & P. Smith E. H. Raworth Auditor & Treasurer South Carolina - Person also appeared before me Charles W. Leamington Greenville County and made oath that he saw that Person and E. H. Raworth had seal and deliver the within written Deed and that he together with E. H. Raworth witnessed the execution of the same to be before him the 29th day of February 1854
