

I now all make by these presents that I, William H. Moore of the State and County aforesaid am Participant of the sum of \$17,000 Seven Thousand Dollars to me paid by Benjamin F. Morely of same County and State aforesaid One Thousand Dollars being paid in Cash and the remainder of sum Hundred Dollars to me paid by the 1st day of November 1873 with interest from this date at the rate of 10 per cent per annum have granted Bargained sold and released and by these Presents do Grant bargained sell and release unto the said Benjamin F. Morely all that tract of Land lying in Greenville County State of South Carolina known as part of the old Dick's tract and containing two hundred acres more or less situated and lying on the Head waters of both the mountains Creek with the Greenville and Augusta Road running through it Beginning on stone corner on Augusta road there A 24 to 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet stones or, thence \$70 £ 26 16 paces £ 20 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ 66.00 to Post road & thence N 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ paces to a Hickory tree, thence E 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ paces to Riverwood & thence N 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 5.60 to last corner for distance N 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ £ 2.65 to Maple tree thence N 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ to small pine & thence S 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ 66 to Beginning corner it being a portion of land originally owned by Samuel Moore aforesaid and transferred by him to his son Fowler G. Moore in trust but by order of the Court of Chancery said land was sold and purchased by Jane C. Moore and by her transferred to William H. Moore together with all and singular the rights, members, inheritances and appurtenances to the said premises together belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin F. Morely his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs my executors or administrators to warrant and defend against all and singular the said premises unto the said Benjamin F. Morely his heirs and assigns against myself and any others persons or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any portion thereof witness my hand and seal this the 16th day of September 1872 signed sealed & delivered in the presence of J.
