Hitchcock & others and moreover to the S. P. Club and places  
together with all and singular the rights members  
hereof determined and appertaining to the said premises  
belonging to me as my wife widow to Robert and  
to those due to said all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said W. J. Pennington his heirs and  
assigns forever And I the said John Pennington auditor or  
account do hereby bind the State of South Carolina to  
warrant and pay all and singular the said  
premises unto the said W. J. Pennington his heirs & assigns  
by and the said State of South Carolina and against  
any person and all persons whomsoever lawfully  
desiring or to claim the same or any part thereof

second day of September in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and forty two and  
in the thirty seventh year of the Independence of
