 for and Consideration of the sum of Two Thousand  
 Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the  
 sealing of these presents by William T. Bates of  
 Greenville County in the State aforesaid the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged. Now therefore  
 I warrant and release and by this presents  
 do warrant, warrant sell and release unto the  
 said William T. Bates all that tract or parcels  
 of land situate lying and being in Greenville  
 County in the State aforesaid on both sides  
 of Salt Fork River between as the following place  
 bounded by lands of William Gibson lands of  
 the O'Neal place, lands of William Cleveland, and  
 others containing three hundred and forty  
 one acres more or less the trees and bounds  
 are more fully described in deed of Wesley  
 Givens to William D. McMath bearing date  
 the 28 day of January AD 1864 and recorded in  
 Register Mississ. Conveyance Book D.D. page 575  
 for Greenville County and witness is hereby made  
 to said deed together with all and singular  
 the rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances  
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 incident or appertaining to have and to hold all  
 and singular the said premises before mentioned unto  
 the said William T. Bates his heirs and assigns  
 forever And we do hereby bind ourselves and our  
 Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant  
 and defend all and singular the said  
 unto the said William T. Bates his heirs and  
 assigns against us and our Heirs and all others  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
 thereof witness our hands and seals this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of  
 January in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight hundred and forty three and in the  
 97<sup>th</sup> year of the sovereignty and Independence of  
 the United States of America signed sealed
