 by the said Parish church towards the receipt whereof is humbly
 acknowledged. Now granted Bergamot Falls and
 referred also by third parties do grant Bergamot
 Falls and all or unto the said Parish Church and her heirs
 and assigns all that tract of Land situate lying
 and lying in the State, and County aforesaid and
 waters of Pond Creek adjoining lands of John Douthit
 and others and containing about two and one fourth
 acres more or less known by the description as last
 made and is represented in a Plot made by Mr.
 Joseph Kelly Deputy Surveyor wherein the same had well
 more fully shown together with all and singular
 the rights herein before mentioned and appurtenances
 whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging or in
 anywise appertaining and the money and
 wherewithal rents issues and profits thereof shall
 also all the estate right title in law to above possession
 property being clear and absolute whatsoever both
 at Law and in Equity of the said Church, Past
 or curators and of all the parties to the said tract
 and of all other persons right having or
 claim the same or any part thereof by force or
 under them or either of them to have and to hold
 the said tract of land with its hereditaments
 privileges and appurtenances unto the said Church
 being her heirs and assigns from me witness whereof
 I the said John Douthit Prothonotary Judge of Greenville County
 under and by virtue of the said deed have caused
 set my hand and seal at Greenville County House
 the 14th day of December in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and forty two AD
