Deed to the State of South Carolina

William A. Austin, Surveyor, Know All Men by  
 These Presents That I, W. A. Manly the City of  
 Greenville of Greenville County in the State  
 of Mississippi in Consideration of the sum of  
 One Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars to me  
 paid William Austin of Rockville County in the  
 State aforesaid have granted and given and  
 released and by these presents do give sell  
 and release unto the said William A. Austin a tract  
 of land surveyed to me by deed March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1870  
 to John A. Read of the City and State of New  
 York beginning at a stone 3<sup>r</sup> thence run due  
 North 44<sup>o</sup> 50' E 50 links to a stone on a ditch line  
 to a willow 3<sup>r</sup> thence along ditch line to a black  
 pine 3<sup>r</sup> thence N 86<sup>o</sup> W 29<sup>o</sup> to a stone on R.R. line three ds.  
 S 10<sup>o</sup> E 31<sup>o</sup> ds to a stone on R.R. line three ds.  
 which 88 links to a stone on 100 yard Road leading  
 to Wilson Bridge thence S 13<sup>o</sup> E 26<sup>o</sup> thence 68 links to  
 a stone 3<sup>r</sup> thence due East 19<sup>o</sup> to a pine 3<sup>r</sup> thence  
 due N to a small P.O. 3<sup>r</sup> thence S 56<sup>o</sup> E 9<sup>o</sup> 36 to a buckeye  
 3<sup>r</sup> thence N 15<sup>o</sup> west 11<sup>o</sup> to a branch three 3<sup>r</sup> thence  
~~S 56<sup>o</sup> E~~ running with the meanders of said Branch  
 to the Beginning Stone 3<sup>r</sup> containing two hundred  
 and twenty five acres less the same more or less  
 adjoining land being and lying on Banks  
 of Grove Creek waters of Saluda River twelve  
 acres sixty eight hundredth of the original tract  
 was sold by Dr. Donald & the above Survey was  
 made by W. A. Austin together with all due singular  
 the rights Members Instruments and appurtenances  
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned  
 unto the said William A. Austin and to his heirs  
 and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs executors and administrators to  
 warrant and defend all and singular  
 the said premises unto the said William A. Austin  
 and his heirs and assigns a good quiet title and  
 my heirs and my other persons whomsoever lawfully  
 coming or to claim the same of any part thereof  
 I deliver my hand and seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of February in the  
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty three  
 in the 97<sup>th</sup> year of the ~~Confederacy~~ bought by & kept as a  
 residence of the United States of America signed sealed and  
 witnessed this 1<sup>st</sup> day of February C. Manly
