Carolina & of the age of twenty two years old
and living in the town of Edgefield in the said
County of Edgefield and being the son of
the 25 day of November in the year one thousand
eight hundred and forty two did subscribe this
Petition in the Court of Probate in the County of
Greenville and State aforesaid praying that the Real
Estate of George W. Alvin Doctor be sold for
divers debts of the said Alvin And who cause being ad-
duced before the Honorable Court aforesaid cause onto
be heard on the fifth day of December in one thousand
eight hundred and forty two when the said cause
after a full hearing thereof and mature deliberation
in the said Court order Adjudged and decree that
the said Real Estate herein after mentioned described
should be sold a public auction by Robt. Southern
Sheriff of said County on the terms and for the
purposes mentioned in said aforesaid order or
by reference or by reference thereto on file in the
said Court will appear And the said G. L.
Southern Sheriff after having duly advertised the
said Real Estate for sale by public outcry on
the eighth day of January in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty three
did then openly and publicly And according to the
Custom of an auction sale and dispose of the said
Real Estate above described unto Washington Taylor
for the sum of forty Dollars, No being
at that price the highest bidder for the said
Cause I know All men that I the said G. L. Southern
Sheriff in consideration of the sum and also in
consideration of the sum of forty Dollars paid me
by the said Washington Taylor the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have granted Bargained sold
and delivered and by these presents do grant Bargain
sell and release unto the said Washington Taylor
and his heirs and assigns all that place parcel
and tract of land situate lying and being
in the County and State aforesaid containing
One and one half acres more or less situate
on a Branch by clear and certain waters of South
Tyger River beginning with all and singular
the rights franchises hereditaments and appurtenances
