 Almond and by these presents do Grant Rogoinda
 Sala and Almond unto the said Engina Ann
 Stone all that Lot of Land in the County and State
 aforesaid on the Rutherford Road joining lands
 now owned by Mrs Erin Louisa Brown and
 Engina Ann Stone and containing two and
 one half acre more or less commencing on the
 in center of said road and running N 83 E 275
 Chs to Stone Thence N 40 E 164 Chs to Stone Thence
 N 82 W 12.70 Chs to Stone in center of said Road
 Thence S 3 E 12.68 Chs in the center of said Road
 to Stone the Beginning corner be used to Dr. L.
 B. Stone by C. P. Jones dated 11 day of April 1846
 & recorded in Register of said County Book
 10 page 359 & 360 this being a portion of a tract
 of 319 acres inherited by me from my Father George
 Mc Carlo. Together with all and singular the rights
 Membris Hereditaments and appurtenances to the
 said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining to have and to hold all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 Engina Ann Stone his heirs assigns forever And I do hereby
 bind my heirs executors administrators to warrant & give
 defend all & singular the said premises unto the said
 Engina Ann Stone his heirs and assigns against
 myself and my heirs and any other person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Witness my hand & seal this 21 day of July in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty three in the sixth
 year of the Independence of the United States of America
