doe I Louis A. Grisham of the County and State aforesaid
O living the daughter of Letitia Hill deceased for and
in Consideration of the sum of Two Dollars to me in
hand a Note by Charles J. Hill of the County and State
aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
and also in Consideration of a Little Due made to me
by the said Charles J. Hill for the tract of Land on
which I now live which tract of Land was purchased
and paid for by my said mother out of his funds
which she inherited from her husband the late Samuel
B. Hill deceased and in which funds or money so
used my said mother had only a lifetime or widow
hood interest under the provisions of the will of her
said deceased husband and at the death of my said
mother the said money or property purchased with it
under the provisions of the said will of the said Samuel
B. Hill deceased belongs to the said Charles J. Hill &
consequently the said tract of Land on which I now
live by the provisions of the said will now belongs
to the said Charles J. Hill. I have given a bond
and released and by these presents do give bond
and release unto the said Charles J. Hill his heirs &
assigns for in all my right title and interest which
I may have or claim either directly or indirectly or
by construction both for myself and as guardian
for my children or by virtue of a Due from Thomas
L. Woodside to the said Letitia Hill (now deceased) Charles
J. Hill and Davis B. Hill dated July 14 "1854 in the
estate property and effect of my said mother Letitia
Hill deceased either present or future the said Due
being intended as a compromise between the parties
to it and also all my right title interest or claim
which I may have or may have as guardian in the
estate of the late Davis B. Hill and presents
or future by construction or otherwise together
with all and singular the rights mentioned
and appurtenance to the same belonging or in
anywise incident or appertaining I have and
hold all and singular the said persons rights
interest and claim or in anywise incident or
appertaining to the same and all property &
effects connected with the same both in the
estates of my said mother and Davis B. Hill
deceased unto the said Charles J. Hill his heirs
and assigns for in And I do hereby bind myself
