 and in consideration of the said sum of ninety five
 Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by
 the said William C. Earle the receipt and payment
 whereof I do truly acknowledge have granted bargained
 and sold and by this present do grant bargain &
 sell unto the said William C. Earle his heirs & assigns
 forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its
 appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest
 which the said Edward Powell of right had of in and
 to the same To have and to hold the said piece parcel
 and tract of Land with its appurtenances unto the
 said William C. Earle his heirs and assigns forever as
 fully and absolutely as I the said John L. Southen might
 could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same
 by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of
 Fieri Facias or otherwise In witness whereof I the said
 John L. Southen have hereunto set my hand and seal the
 5th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and seventy two
