W Mitchell Esq I now all men by these presents that we Elijah Henson and Eliza Henson wife of Elijah Henson of this County and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and fifty Dollars to us in hand paid by William Mitchell of the State and County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Mitchell a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the State and County aforesaid on South side of Middle Tyger River and adjoining land of Elisabeth Jane Henson Thomas le Lester & others Beginning at a Stake in the road and running with Elisabeth Jane Henson line N<sup>o</sup> 1/4 W 26.50 to a Stake then N 2.50 to a white oak tree N<sup>o</sup> 3/4 W 9.00 to a Stake then up said middle Tyger river N 9.30 to a Stake then S<sup>o</sup> 1/4 E 7.18 to a poplar tree S<sup>o</sup> 5 W 130 to a Stake thence S<sup>o</sup> 1/4 E 29.50 with Thos. C. Lester's line to a Stake in the road then down said Tyger road to the Beginning corner containing forty seven & 2/3 acres more or less said lot or tract of land being that surveyed and laid out by James R. Dickson Esq in accordance with last will and testament of Simon Lester dec'd and by direction of Moses H. Lester and David C Lester Executors of said will, and drawn by Rosalinda D. Morrow together with all and singular the rights, franchises, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Mitchell his heirs and assigns forever And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & defend all & singular the said premises unto the said William Mitchell his heirs & assigns forever and against us and our heirs and against every person who may lawfully claim the same or any part thereof Witness our hands seals this the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty three
