between J L Southern Esquire Sheriff of Greenville County
South Carolina of the one part and P G Green of the other
part witnesseth Whereby Emma W Westfield on on
about the 20th day of December in the year of our
Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy three
did exhibit his petition in the Court of Probate at Green-
ville Court house in the County of Greenville and State
aforesaid against Mary Westfield and John O West-
field praying for a sale of the Real Estate of John
Westfield dead for partition among the legal heirs
and for the purpose of liquidating his indebtedness
And the cause being at issue before the Honorable
Court aforesaid come on to be heard on the 3^d day of Janu-
ary in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
