

James Barnett	Deed	The State of South Carolina I know all knew by these presents That I James Barnett of Greenville County in the State aforesaid by my hundred Dollars to me hands by James Gosnell of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Gosnell a tract piece or parcel of Land lying being and situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Green Creek waters of South Pacolet River bounded by lands of James Goodlett & Grammell James Gosnell and myself being part of a tract of land conveyed to me by James M'Kain Nov 22 1816 known as the Humphrey Paris Tract of Land and runs as follows Beginning at a Stake 3x in the road on back line thence N 6 E 734 chains to a White Oak 3x called P O on Davis flat thence N 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to a Chestnut 3x thence N 45 W 730 $\frac{1}{2}$ chs to a pine 3x thence N 16 W 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ chs to Forked Chestnut 3x thence South 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ chs to a Stake 3x chestnut gone thence S 86 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 475 chains to a Black Oak 3x thence N 4 E 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to a small sapling White Oak 3x thence N 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to a pine 3x thence N 40 E 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to stake 3x in road thence N 35 E 155 chains along road crossing Creek to a Stone in road thence N 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 95 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to a Stake in road thence N 74 E 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to the beginning Stake 3x containing One hundred and forty eight acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Gosnell his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Gosnell his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whom ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this tenth day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy four and in the ninety eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of M <sup>r</sup> Davis
