 Know all men by these presents that I Henry O Cauble of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five thousand Dollars to me paid by James Panmister of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Panmister for all that piece parcel and tract of Land situated lying and being in Greenville County State South Carolina on both sides of Enoree River the following metes and bounds and including the saw Grist Mills - beginning at the bridge on Enoree River known as Caubles Bridge running thence North thirty yards to Oak tree near two persimmon trees thence East to Dead Walnut on top of Ridge near Crowders Corner thence with Crowders line North to Caubles old line thence with Caubles old line North west to land sold Jeremiah & Samuel Foster to a Post Oak being corner of Cauble and Foster's Land on Rutherford Road thence North west with old Rutherford Road to a Post Oak corner near old Mill road being Duckets & Caubles corner thence west with Ducketts line to Enoree River thence across Enoree River with George Ducketts line to corner of George Ducketts laid on South side of River thence South east to persimmon tree marked with a cross on Rutherford Road - thence east with said Rutherford Road to the beginning corner containing five hundred Acres more or less being a part of the land deeded to Peter Cauble by Martin Ayres and others and I hereby convey to the said James Panmister his heirs and assigns forever all the water privileges conveyed to Reubin Ayres by Aaron Kemp by deed bearing date 13 day of December 1834 as Recorded in Register Book 3 page 438 Together with all and singular the rights members hereunto and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the Rights members hereunto and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises
