 Greenville and State aforesaid against Eliza C D Bozeman praying  
 that the Real Estate of J L Bozeman be sold for partition among  
 the heirs to And the cause came on to be heard on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May  
 in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy four  
 when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation  
 in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the said Real
