558 G W Gilbreath Deed The State of South Carolina Greenville County Know all men by these presents that I Geo W Gilbreath of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of Natural love and affection for my beloved wife Chinnia L Gilbreath do by these presents grant and release unto my said wife Chinnia L Gilbreath all those two certain pieces and parcels of Land purchased by me from John B Gilbreath for which I have a Deed bearing date the thirteenth day of June One thousand eight hundred and seventy one and witnessed by J B Gilgram and James M Ashmore and recorded in Book D D page 159 November the 25th 1871 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto my said wife Chinnia L Gilbreath her heirs and assigns forever And I

administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto my wife Chinnia L Gilbreath her heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof I also for the consideration of natural love and affection for my wife Chinnia L Gilbreath do give her all of my personal property of every description consisting of battle hogs Buggy house hold and kitchen furniture and books to wit Seventy five I require my wife Chinnia L Gilbreath to pay out of my personal property all of my just debts in case I do not pay them myself I George W Gilbreath do hereby reserve thought to alter change or amend the above deed of Gifts to my wife Chinnia L Gilbreath both as to Land and personal property should I conclude to do so If not then they are to remain in full force and virtue and my wife is not authorized to sell control or dispose of any part thereof during my life without my written consent but after my death she is entitled to take full possession and to use or dispose of the same in any manner she pleases In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the first day of July One thousand eight hundred and seventy four and in the eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of W A Howell S B Poole W B Goodlett George W Gilbreath
