of Mr Jon Felix Rodgers deceased of the State and Dis-
trict alone laid have appointed the said W W Butler
as Trustee to take charge of the land and I have granted
bargained sold and released unto the said W W
Butler as Trustee and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto W W Butler as Trustee for
Commodore Rodgers Martha Ann Rodgers Mary Elizabeth
Rodgers and Amanda Rodgers all that tract of land or
Parcell of land containing Fifty Acres more or less
situated lying and being in the State and District
aforesaid on Maple Creek branch waters of Reedy River
