that I William Goldsmith of
Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration
of the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars to me paid by
William J Long of Greenville County in the State
aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said William J Long all that tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in Greenville County
South Carolina on both sides of Sildus Creek water
of Enoree River containing seven hundred & thirteen
acres more or less and comprising them adjoining tracts
as follows, to wit, one tract of land containing six hun-
dred and fifty six acres more or less being the tract
conveyed to the said William Goldsmith on the twenty
third day of October eighteen hundred and fifty
six and having such lines metes and bounds as
appear from a plat of the same recorded in Book 14 page
19 of the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance for
Greenville County one tract containing forty eight acres
more or less adjoining the above on the South and parti-
cularly described in a deed to the same from Samuel
Louthin, Probate Judge of Greenville County bearing
date November second eighteen hundred and sixty
eight, and a tract of nine acres more or less composed
of two small tracts purchased from John Doyle by
said Goldsmith. Together with all and singular the
Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the
said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or
appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned, unto the said William
