State aforesaid said lots bought of W. T. Shumate
one on the 15th day of November 1880 containing
one acre more or less the other lot bought
on the 29th of December 1880 containing one and
one third acres more or less for course and
distance of said lots will more fully appear on
said titles made to me by the said W. T. Shumate
on the respective dates given above.

Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said pre-
mises belonging or in anywise incident or appert-
aining. To have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said
L. C. Zimmerman his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said
L. C. Zimmerman his heirs and assigns against

shall come, I Perry, D. Gil-
bath, Sheriff of Greenville
County and State aforesaid, send greeting: whereas, by

virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court
of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, tested
the tenth day of January in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and eighty two at the suit of
William McKimney Executor of the estate of James
McKinney Plaintiff and Solomon Walls Defendant,
some directed, commanding me that of the goods
and chattels lands and tenements of Solomon Walls
to levy the sum of Fifty six and 4/100 Dollars damage
