of the sum of Four hundred Dollars to me paid
by Miss Elizabeth Prasher in the State aforesaid,
have granted bargained sold and released, and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Miss Elizabeth Prasher all that
parcel or tract of land being and being on
head water of Crab Creek and containing

one hundred acres more or less being the same tract
of land deeded to me by Thomas Prasher as a gift on
the 14th day of May 1836 adjoining lands of J. B. Beunet
James S. Ashmore and others. Together with all and
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appur-
tenances to the said premises belonging, or in
anywise incident, or appertaining. To have and
to hold, all and singular the said premises before
mentioned, unto the said Miss Elizabeth Prasher her
heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind
myself and my heirs, executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend, all and singu-
lar the said premises unto the said Miss Elizabeth
Prasher her heirs and assigns, against and my
heirs, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same
or any part thereof.
