County in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty five Dollars to me paid by James A. Cannon of Greenville County and in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James A. Cannon all that piece parcel or tract of land lying on the South side of the Georgia road on waters of North Rabun Creek, waters of Reedy River being in the County and State aforesaid and Fairview Township, beginning at a stone on the Georgia Road, thence along said road 16 chains and 86 links to a stake thence S 75 E 44.00 to a red oak 0.7 m thence N 8.86 to a stake 3 x 7 m thence N 70 W 15.90 to a stake 3 x 7 m thence N 47 W 15 to the beginning stone corner in the aforesaid road containing thirty two acres more or less, bounded by lands of Mrs M. M. McGehee N Cannon, S. C. Dickson and Cornelias and Stephen Vaughn. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said James A. Cannon, his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James A. Cannon, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and assigns and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
