sell and release, unto the said J. B. Humphreys
all that tract of land, situate lying and being in
the County and State aforesaid, on waters of North
Saluda River, Beginning at a stake at the old pier
on said river, thence West 20° 40' to the head of a ditch
thence N. 87 1/2 W 12° 00' to a lightwood stake 3x3x0.m.
thence S 26° E 5° to a stake at the head of a branch,
thence down said branch 32.44 to a stone 3x thene
S 36 1/2 E 9.60 to a chestnut oak 3x3x0.m. thence S 27 1/2
