sideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred and
eighty Dollars to me paid by May F Paul in the
State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release, unto the said May F Paul, all
that tract and parcel of land situate in the County of
Greenville and State aforesaid, on branch waters of Reedy
River about four and a half miles North of Greenville
Court House, Beginning at a sweet gum corner, thence
N 50 7/4 W 97.0 chs to a stake, thence N 35 W 6 chs to a stone
corner, thence N 65 W 2.50 chs to a stake corner of
John C Davidson, thence N 30 E 6.33 chs to a stake
corner, thence N 53 E 4 chs to a stake corner, thence
N 34 E 5.50 chs to a Rock corner, thence N 71 E 7.50
chs to a stake corner, thence N 30 E 3.50 chs to a
Large sweet gum corner, thence N 71 E to the
line known as the Thompson land, thence with
said line to the head of a hollow forming a
branch line, thence down the meandering of
said hollow and branch to the beginning corner
containing One hundred and fifteen acres
more or less, and bounded by lands of John C Davidson
Choirs lands, A Neely and Thompson lands and
particularly described, as to metes and boundaries
in a plat hereto attached, made by H. P. Johnson
bearing date June 5th 1878.
