County aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas Hiram  
C. Markley on or about the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1880  
exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common  
Pleas, for the County aforesaid against Roxannah  
J. Cox, Louise S. Gaines, Mary E. Cox, Anna  
R. Cox, St. John Cox in his own right and as  
administrator of Thomas M. Cox deceased, and  
Thomas A. Cox, demanding judgment in relation  
to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and de-  
scribed; and the cause being at issue, came on to be  
heard on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 1882, and such proceed-
