do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said Mary
Nelson all my one half interest in all that certain piece
parcel and tract of land containing one hundred and
fifty acres more or less situate and being in the County
of Greenville in the State aforesaid adjoining lands of
Stouid and others it being the tract of land on
which Groce resided in 1873 & same land purchased
by me at Sheriff's sale in 1873

Together with all and singular the rights, members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-
ises belonging, or in any wise incident or appert-
ainings. To have and to hold, all and singular
the said premises before mentioned unto the said
Mary Nelson her heirs and assigns forever,
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
and administrators, to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said Mary Nelson her heirs and assigns,
against one and every heirs, & every other person whom
soever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or
any part thereof.
