into between M. V. Park-
ley of the first part, and Daniel Johnson tenant
col the second part, witnesses: That Parkley hereby
agrees to rent Johnson a certain piece of land
in Grove Township, Greenville County S. C. and
known as the "Old John Richardson place" lying
west of Grove Creek bottoms (excepting the
creek bottoms) but including the branch
bottoms on that place, for the term of 2
years, commencing on the first of January
1883 whenever any of these lands are out-
let to the public by the government.

clear up and cultivate the same using the same
wood himself for fire wood. Parkley engages to
erect a comfortable dwelling house for said
Johnson, of a size proportioned to his wants, and
to have the same ready for occupancy on or before
the 1st of January 1886, and Parkley will also furnish
Johnson with board timber nails etc for any shelter
he may choose to build, as well as fire wood. In con-
sideration for all the aforesaid privaleges, Johnson
hereby engages and agrees to cultivate carefully and
properly as many of the above acre as he may choose
to plant and cultivate, and so to pay for the first year
one thousand pounds of good merchantable cotton on
or before the 10th day of Oct 1886 and for the second
year he is to pay twelve hundred lbs of good mer-
chantable cotton on or before the 10th of October 1884
deliverable property baled to M. V. Parkley or his
representative or agent.

It is thereby specially understood and agreed between
the aforesaid contracting parties that any & all
crops raised by Johnson upon the aforesaid
land is hereby held liable and responsible for the
aforesaid current value of cotton for the
above named amount of rent
