Parsons and Henry Hayes partners in trade under firm name of Wheeler Parsons & Hayes of the State of New York in the State of aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred (\$800) Dollars and other good and valuable consideration to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Isaac M. Bryan in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Isaac M. Bryan his heirs and assigns all that piece parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the City of Greenville County of Greenville and State of South Carolina between the streets of Washington and John near the Air Line Railroad Depot containing one acre more or less and having such marks and bounds as follows viz: Beginning at a stake on Washington Street thence 39 1/2 ft 4.95 to a stake on Washington John Street thence along said street 50 1/2 ft 200 feet to a stake thence 39 1/2 ft 4.95 to a stake thence along Washington Street 50 1/2 ft 200 feet to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Isaac M. Bryan his Heirs and Assigns forever And we do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs Executors and Administrators Servants and forever defend all and singular the said premises
